We Need YOU to run/walk for 2 miles to help someone who is hungry

No Hungry Neighbors is an endeavor of the North Carolina Annual Conference to help with the enormous hunger problem that we have within the boundaries of our state and eastern North Carolina in particular. Working in conjunction with local Food Banks and the Society of St Andrew, each youth group can help with this endeavor by raising funds that directly benefit the *No Hungry Neighbors* project. Each participant at Pilgrimage 2003 is asked to either run or walk two miles to help those in need. The two mile course will be set up in the parking lot on the grounds of the Coliseum Complex. In advance of that weekend, youth and adults who will be attending Pilgrimage will need to ask for and collect financial contributions (cash or checks made payable to No Hungry Neighbors) that will be used to aid the hungry. ALL money must be turned in at Pilgrimage - financial pledges cannot be accepted! A T-shirt will be given to each individual raising at least \$20 and bringing that money to Pilgrimage. In addition, the top three individual money raisers from throughout the Conference will receive a monetary award of \$150 for first place, \$75 for second place and \$50 for third place. The top three youth groups raising the most money (factoring for group size) will also receive monetary awards of the same value. The youth group overall raising the most money will receive a stylish engraved "cup" (ala hockey's Stanley Cup) for the youth group to keep for a year.

On the reverse side you will find the registration sheet for your group for the Run/Walk. This page may be photocopied as many times as needed. There will be a special run/walk registration table set up at the North Entrance of the Crown Coliseum for one adult group leader to turn in the registration sheet(s) and all money raised for the run/walk on Friday night or Saturday morning. Please use one heavy duty brown 9"x12" envelope to turn in registration sheet(s) and money raised. The group leader will be given the T-shirts for group members raising at least \$20 each.

Please note: Any youth or youth group not able to be present at Pilgrimage on Saturday, November 8 may still participate by running/walking in their home area. For those running or walking two miles in their home area and collecting at least \$20 per person, a T-shirt will be given upon request.
